<b>Ownership or Control Type:</b>	
<b>Government, Federal</b>	Controlled by an agency or department of the US or international government.
Department of Defense	
Indian Health Service	
Public Health Service (Other than Indian Health Service)

Other Federal	
<b>Tribal Governance</b>	Controlled by a tribal agency or department of the US or international government.
<b>Government, Non-Federal</b>	
State	Controlled by an agency of state government.
County	Controlled by an agency of county government.
City	Controlled by an agency of municipal government.
City-County	Controlled jointly by agencies of municipal and county governments.
Hospital District or Authority	Controlled by a political subdivision of a state, county, or city created solely for the purpose of establishing and maintaining medical care or health-related care institutions.
<b>Non-Government, Not-for-Profit</b>	Controlled by non-profit organizations, including religious organizations (e.g., a Catholic hospital), community hospitals, cooperative hospitals, hospitals operated by fraternal societies, etc. May also include federally qualified health centers (FQHCs).

<b>Investor-Owned, For-Profit</b>	Controlled on a for-profit basis by an individual, partnership, a profit-making corporation, or private equity.

<b>Physician-Owned, Not Incorporated</b>	Owned by an individual or group of physicians and not incorporated.
